

The Teacher Storyteller and her Storytelling Children

The first goal of this workshop will be to give ECE teachers a chance to explore storytelling outside the book – that is - telling stories rather than reading stories. The second goal will be for participants to transfer the art of telling the stories to the children in their care. A three-part method of teaching storytelling to children will be presented. This small group method involves teacher telling, teacher prompting and finally children telling. This three-part method of storytelling can be used to promote literacy skills, math skills, drama skills and creative movement skills.
